Pestech unit to construct hydro plant in Cambodia

PESTECH International Bhd has executed a construction agreement with Alex Corp for the design, engineering, manufacturing, installation, testing and commissioning of the 230kV Stung Tatay Hydro Power Plant-Phnom Penh Transmission System Project in Cambodia for US\$100.21 million (RM444.58 million).

The contract will be undertaken via Pestech's wholly owned subsidiary, Pestech (Cambodia) Ltd..

The project mainly involves the setting up of a 220km 230kV double circuit transmission line from Stung Tatay Hydro Power Plant to Phnom Penh and the supply, installation and connection of two 230kV lines bays at Stung Tatay Hydro Power Plant switchyard. It is expected to commence within three months from the date of the agreement, with expected completion of 36 months from the commencement date, Pestech noted in a filing yesterday.
